



Baxby Awakening – Health & Safety & Site Guidelines

To keep everyone safe and ensure a smooth-running weekend, we ask all contributors, traders and volunteers to read and follow these guidelines while on-site.

Vehicle Movement:

Vehicles may only enter or exit the designated event areas during approved setup and pack-down times. No driving is permitted within active festival zones once gates open to the public.

Fire Safety:

Open flames are only allowed in designated fire pits or cooking areas. Please follow all instructions from the site team and keep a safe distance from flammable materials.

First Aid:

First aid support will be available onsite throughout the event. If you require assistance or notice a safety concern, report it immediately to a member of staff.

Noise & Respect:

Please respect quiet hours and other festival guests, especially during late evenings and early mornings.

Safeguarding:

Any workshops involving emotional or mental-health themes must be delivered within safe boundaries. Facilitators must avoid giving medical advice or engaging in one-to-one therapeutic interventions unless professionally qualified.

Waste:

Please keep your area clean and dispose of waste responsibly. Vendors must remove their own rubbish at the end of the event.
